We continue to be grateful for the generosity of our St. Ignatius Loyola parishioners whose contributions of \$1.5 million in donations and pledges to the campaign have helped to provide resources for parishes, investments in youth ministry and campus chaplaincy programs, and restoration work at St. Michael's Cathedral.
