**Confirmation Preparation Programme Begins!**

The Grade 7 students in our parish schools have received their Confirmation Registration forms at school and are invited to the Registration/Enrollment Meeting in the parish hall on either ***Tuesday, December 5 OR Wednesday, December 6***. Registration begins at 6:30 p.m. and the Meeting begins at 7:00 p.m. Candidates, parents/guardians, and *sponsors* are asked to attend.

For those in Grades 7 who are *not* enrolled in our parish Catholic schools (e.g. Public -School Students, Private School Students), are asked to pick up registration materials at our parish office in the coming weeks. Classes for those not enrolled in our Catholic schools will begin in late January on Thursday afternoons from 4:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. in the chapel area.

Any older youth or adults wishing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in May 2018 are asked to contact Fr. Charles as soon as possible.

**2018 Offertory Envelopes/Pre-Authorized Giving...**

Offertory envelopes for 2018 are available for pick up in the vestibule. Please continue to include your first and last name and address (or an address label) on the first 3 envelopes. Your new envelope number will be recorded so there is no need to search for your 2017 envelope box.

If you are not currently registered in the parish and wish to use Offertory envelopes, please fill out the parish registration form on the table noting your envelope number and return the form to the parish office.

I thank those who are currently using Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) here at the parish and remind them to pick up a box of 2018 envelopes for the special collection envelopes that are not part of PAG. I myself use PAG, and would strongly encourage this practice for others - especially for those who are away from the parish on a seasonal basis. Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) allows families and individuals to specify a monthly donation amount to the parish, and to have this amount directly withdrawn from their bank account through a pre-authorized debit. **Family of Faith Update...**

We continue to be grateful for the generosity of our St. Ignatius Loyola parishioners whose contributions of \$1.5 million in donations and pledges to the campaign have helped to provide resources for parishes, investments in youth ministry and campus chaplaincy programs, and restoration work at St. Michael's Cathedral. We will retain our share of \$645,000 of these funds here at the parish to offset the cost of our 2015 parking expansion/Glen Erin Drive access project which has had such a positive effect on our weekend mass parking problem. As of June 30, 2017, we have received \$211,178 of this amount through your generosity!
