**Family of Faith Update...**

We continue to be grateful for the generosity of our parishioners here at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish, whose contributions of \$1.5 million in donations and pledges to the campaign have helped to provide resources for parishes, investments in youth ministry, campus chaplaincy programs and restoration work at St. Michael's Cathedral. We will retain our share of these funds totalling \$645,000 here at the parish level to offset the cost of our 2015 parking expansion/Glen Erin Drive access project which has had such a positive effect on our weekend mass parking problem. As of June 30, 2017, through your generosity we have received \$211,178.
