

### On this Fourth Sunday of Advent...

...We meet the figure of Joseph, of the house of David, who receives word that his intended wife is the faithful instrument in God's plan to save the world through the gift of the Son she has conceived through the power of the Holy Spirit. In this way, the prophesy of Isaiah has been fulfilled: *"Behold the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel"* which means, *"God is with us".* 

Let us prepare our hearts for our Christmas so that we too can be faithful instruments of God that welcoming Christ into our own hearts and lives.

## Family of Faith Update...

We continue to be grateful for the generosity of our parishioners here at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish, whose contributions of \$1.5 million in donations and pledges to the campaign have helped to provide resources for parishes, investments in youth ministry and campus chaplaincy programs and restoration work at St. Michael's Cathedral. We will retain our share of \$645,000 of these funds here at the parish level to offset the cost of our 2015 parking expansion/Glen Erin Drive access project which has had such a positive effect on our weekend mass parking problem. As of June 30, 2017, we have received \$211,178 through your generosity!

Pledge amounts given through cheque, credit card or donation of securities prior to December 31 will receive a 2017 tax receipt directly from the Family of Faith campaign office. If you wish to make any additional payments on your pledges prior to year-end, they too will receive a tax receipt for 2017. **Major Relic of Saint Francis Xavier to visit the Archdiocese of Toronto -** A first-degree relic of missionary Saint Francis Xavier is coming to the Archdiocese of Toronto on January 12-14, 2018. The forearm of the saint is permanently displayed at the Church of the Gesù in Rome. The relic will be hosted by St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica on January 12, at St. Francis Xavier Church, Mississauga on January 13, and at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, Toronto on January 14. The body of St. Francis Xavier, which is buried in Goa, India, as well as the relic of his arm, are incorrupt—they have not experienced natural decay since his death in 1552. Organizers expect close to 100,000 people will visit the various events across the country—the same number of people it is believed Francis baptized with his right arm and hand.
