Little Rock Bible Study - The Word of God at Vatican II...

Did you ever wonder how the Bible became such an essential part of being a Catholic in our Day? *Dei Verbum—The Dogmatic Constitution on Divine Revelation*—remains one of the foundational teachings of the Second Vatican Council. Vatican II gave rise to a new generation of Catholics who were eager to delve into the Scriptures, to study and pray with them, and to live boldly in response to the truth they discovered there.

We begin this 5-week Thursday evening bible study with a special introduction on Thursday, January 25 by our associate pastor Fr. Charles Egbulefu, CCE, whose doctoral thesis touches upon Vatican II and *Dei Verbum*, and its foundational and life-giving teaching that shapes our Catholic understanding of Scripture and Tradition. Along the way, especially in Lessons Two and Three, you will also work with select Scripture passages to further your appreciation of Scripture, for the church's encouragement since the council stresses that "access to sacred scripture ought to be widely available to the Christian faithful" (*Dei Verbum* 22).

Please join us for five Thursdays from January 25 to February 22 at 7:00 p.m. in the parish hall. The registration fee is \$20 per participant. All are welcome!

Lenten Series 2018- Living Out LAUDATO SI - March 1, 8, 15, 2 at 7:00 p.m.

Written into creation and the created order is the challenge to live respectfully together on this planet, and to care for our common home; God has given us this challenge. Scripture tells us that when God created the natural world, he saw that it was good (Genesis 1.25). It has long been a fundamental teaching of Christianity that the physical universe has an important role to play in God's plan, and our faith in spiritual things does not mean a rejection or devaluation of material realities.

Pope Francis, in his encyclical, *Laudato Si'*, sounds an alarm that we have lost our way in addressing this basic human and Christian calling. Our world is falling into serious disrepair, and our way of living is threatening future life on the planet. This key Pope Francis document addresses ecological and environmental concerns in a robust way, but within the context of a larger concern with the needs of the whole human family... continued....

It presents a vision of integral human development, where human dignity is upheld, the world's poorest are attended to, and environmental, moral, social and political challenges are addressed in an integrated way.

Our Lenten series of three evenings (Thursdays March 1, 8, 15 from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m.) will help us as Catholics to engage more deeply with the challenge of *Laudato Si* in our own Canadian context, and to take up Pope Francis' invitation to engage in an open and honest conversation about our current crises concerning the environment, our economies and our societies.
