From the Desk of Fr. Tim...

Hope for Haiti- Humanitarian Relief Collection...

This weekend we welcome Maria Masucci, principal of St. Mark's School to speak at each mass about the *Hope for Haiti* initiative, an ongoing grassroots initiative that has supported the construction of a school (Le Bon Pasteur) and the restoration of university classrooms (Notre Dame University) in Jacmel, Haiti since the devastating earthquake eight years ago.

This year, our three parish schools will join with others in the Dufferin Peel Catholic District School Board as we ask our Grade 7 Confirmation Candidates to assist with filling and shipping a large container to help support the educational, nutritional and medical needs of Jacmel. In May, parishioners will be invited to take part in donating material goods that support the educational, nutritional and medical needs of impoverished families and students. Once full, the container will be sent to Jacmel, Haiti. More details will be announced in the coming months.

As a parish community, our present focus is to fund the shipping costs of the container through next weekend's special **Humanitarian Relief Collection**. Cheques should be made payable to St. Ignatius Loyola Parish- Hope for Haiti. Thank you for your generous support!

World Day of the Sick/Mass for the Anointing of the Sick...

When Pope John Paul II established the *World Day of the Sick* on the memorial of our Lady of Lourdes he was "*reminding us to see in our sick brother or sister the face of Christ*", and of our own need for healing and the Church's care for those who are ill and those who care for them. I take this opportunity to thank the many people involved in our Pastoral Care Team who minister to the sick by offering holy communion to them at home, at Sunrise and Parklands on the Green, or at Credit Valley Hospital.

On Saturday, February 10 at 9:00 a.m., we will celebrate a special Mass for the Anointing of the Sick. Please extend an invitation to those Roman Catholics in your families whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age, as we would be happy to anoint them during the mass.

Finally, a reminder that if you have a loved one who is homebound, or seriously ill please call the parish office to arrange for one of our priests to come for an initial visit and possible Anointing of the Sick. We would then be happy to offer them the option of receiving communion at home through our Pastoral Care Team.

Lenten Series 2018- Living Out LAUDATO SI - March 1, 8, 15 at 7:00 p.m...

Written into creation and the created order is the challenge to live respectfully together on this planet, and to care for our common home; God has given us this challenge. Scripture tells us that when God created the natural world, he saw that it was good (Genesis 1.25). It has long been a fundamental teaching of Christianity that the physical universe has an important role to play in God's plan, and our faith in spiritual things does not mean a rejection or devaluation of material realities.

Pope Francis, in his encyclical, *Laudato Si'*, sounds an alarm that we have lost our way in addressing this basic human and Christian calling. Our world is falling into serious disrepair, and our way of living is threatening future life on the planet. This key Pope Francis document addresses ecological and environmental concerns in a robust way, but within the context of a larger concern with the needs of the whole human family. It presents a vision of integral human development, where human dignity is upheld, the world's poorest are attended to, and environmental, moral, social and political challenges are addressed in an integrated way.

Our Lenten series of three evenings (Thursdays March 1, 8, 15 from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.) will help us as Catholics to engage more deeply with the challenge of *Laudato Si'* in our own Canadian context, and to take up Pope Francis' invitation to engage in an open and honest conversation about our current crises concerning the environment, our economies and our societies. Copies of the document *Laudato Si'* are available from the parish office for \$5 each, and we recommend that the document be read before the Series begins. Join us!
