## Annual Financial Report to the Parish...

As we present our 2017 Annual Financial Report this weekend I wish to thank each of you for your continued support of our parish. Total collections were up nearly 5% from 2016 levels. This is largely attributable to the increase in donations to ShareLife, Mission Co-op, and Humanitarian Relief for the drought in Africa (matched by the Canadian Government), as well as for the hurricanes in the Caribbean and the earthquakes in Mexico.

Special thanks to those who continue to fulfil your pledges to the Family of Faith. This year \$92,000 has been collected and added to our parish capital fund to offset the cost of the recent parking expansion project. Tax receipts for your Family of Faith donations will be mailed to you directly from the Archdiocese.

Our parish expenditures, excluding Special Collections, Refugee Sponsorship expenses and a large 2016 HST refund, were down slightly when compared to 2016. This past year we did complete one capital project: the hall foyer expansion and door replacement, which has really improved traffic flow in that area of our church.

Our parish currently has a capital fund balance of \$1,879,849 on deposit with the Archdiocese. While these funds remain the property of our parish, the Archdiocese loans them out to other parishes to assist them in the building and renovation of churches, while paying interest on the fund balance. While a capital fund of \$1.9 million is a significant amount of money, the planned replacement of our peaked roofs this coming spring with a synthetic slate roof, new skylights and more insulation is projected to cost \$750,000. Other upcoming projects may include the replacement of the heating and air conditioning units and a possible retrofit of the offices and meeting rooms.

Tax receipts for the year 2017 are available in the main foyer of the church today. As your pastor, I thank you sincerely for your continued and generous support - both financial and in your dedicated service to our parish community. It is a privilege to be the pastor of this busy and vibrant parish! I also wish to thank the members of our Property and Finance Committee who are presenting the financial report at each mass this weekend, and the entire committee for their wise advice and assistance: Barry Derks, Michael Furlong, Peter Kastelic, Maureen Kelly, Tom Pippy and Mariette Sequeira and Bob Stevens.

### THANK YOU FOR YOUR GENEROSITY
