Easter Triduum...

More and more Catholics are re-discovering the richness of experiencing the Easter Triduum in its three parts – Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:30 p.m., one of our three Good Friday Services at 10:30 a.m. (Children's Celebration), 1:00 p.m. or 3:00 p.m., and the Easter Vigil on Saturday, March 31 at 8:00 p.m. I invite you to make these three celebrations your priority in Holy Week 2018.
