Last year, at *ShareLife*-funded agencies that assist young mothers, over 1,000 clients like Camila received support for their new families.

Roofing Project Update...

We thank Semple Gooder Roofing Company for their good work on the replacement of the peaked roofs thus far. We are almost half-way to our projected completion date in early July - weather permitting! The good news is that the roof deck (below the old roof) is in good shape, the bad news is that we found extensive evidence of an infestation of squirrels that had made their nests and passageways in the old roof...contributing to the water damage that we have seen in recent years! In the coming weeks you should be able to see the application of the new roofing shingles (midnight black synthetic slate) in place on top of expanded insulation and new skylights. Through your generosity over the past years we have been able to pay for this project from our funds on deposit with the Archdiocese of Toronto.

Family of Faith Update...

As many of you remember, just over 2 years ago we completed our active fundraising for our parish's Family of Faith campaign. Your participation in this important program not only greatly helps our parish, it is helping to fund the following initiatives as outlined in the Archdiocese of Toronto's Pastoral Plan:

- *Providing financial support to parishes to help ensure growth and sustainability;
- *Supporting Catholic education through parish and campus-based ministry (like University of Toronto Mississauga) to keep our youth engaged in an active life of faith;
- *Investing in resources that will help our clergy grow and be the pastoral leaders we all rely on them to be;
- *Ensuring there is a strong Catholic voice in an increasingly secular world;
- *Restoring and enhancing the beauty of St. Michael's Cathedral as the mother church of all Catholics in the Archdiocese;
- *Establishing a new capital fund to provide financing to new churches and to support those parish communities that may be struggling with significant building issues.

I continue to be very grateful for the success of our parish campaign which raised \$1.5 million in donations and pledges! We will retain over \$650,000 of this amount at the parish level to offset the cost of our 2016 parking expansion/Glen Erin Drive access project which has had such a positive effect on our weekend mass parking problem. Through parishioners fulfilling their pledges and making their payments up until December 31, 2017, the parish has already received \$249,605.
