If you are from this parish and intend to ask for a reference letter, please note that you will have to be attending Mass here regularly before such a recommendation will be given. If the teacher candidate is currently attending Teacher's College and intends to use St. Ignatius Loyola parish to request the pastoral reference and they are away at school, they will be required to obtain a letter from the pastor of the parish where they are attending while away at school.

# Family of Faith Update...

As many of you remember, just over 2 years ago we completed our active fundraising for our parish's *Family of Faith* campaign. Your participation in this important program not only greatly helps our parish, it is helping to fund the following initiatives as outlined in the Archdiocese of Toronto's Pastoral Plan:

•Providing financial support to parishes to help ensure growth and sustainability;

- •Supporting Catholic education through parish and campus- based ministry (like University of Toronto Mississauga) to keep our youth engaged in an active life of faith;
- Investing in resources that will help our clergy grow and be the pastoral leaders we all rely on them to be;
  Ensuring there is a strong Catholic voice in an increasingly secular world;
- •Restoring and enhancing the beauty of St. Michael's Cathedral as the mother church of all Catholics in the Archdiocese;
- •Establishing a new capital fund to provide financing to new churches and to support those parish communities that may be struggling with significant building issues.

I continue to be very grateful for the success of our parish campaign which raised \$1.5 million in donations and pledges! We will retain over \$650,000 of this amount at the parish level to offset the cost of our 2016 parking expansion/Glen Erin Drive access project- which has had such a positive effect on our weekend mass parking problem. Through parishioners fulfilling their pledges and making their payments up until December 31, 2017, the parish has already received \$249,605.
