Donation from the Sisters of St. Joseph Morrow Park Convent...

For 175 years, the Sisters of St. Joseph have been present in our Archdiocese whether it be in our hospitals (St. Michael's, St. Joseph's, Providence Centre), our high schools (St. Joseph's Islington, St. Joseph College School, St. Joseph Morrow Park), in many elementary schools and in other ministries. Many of you may have either been born or educated in one of their hospitals or schools!

In 2010, the Sisters sold their large Morrow Park motherhouse (Bayview south of Steeles) and moved to a smaller facility in Toronto (2 O'Connor Drive). At that time, as Pastor of Our Lady of Grace Parish, Aurora, I was planning a new church and gratefully received the donation of the Corpus of Christ from the beautiful Morrow Park Chapel. The unique Corpus of Christ measures just over 10 feet in height and was specially commissioned by the Sisters for the building of the chapel in 1961. It is handcrafted entirely of white pear wood.

The parish in Aurora is now renovating its current church and cannot fit the Corpus of Christ into the new sanctuary. The Sisters of St. Joseph were also assisted in their founding in France by a Jesuit priest (Fr. Jean-Pierre Médaille, sj. & the Sisters at Morrow Park have always had a Jesuit priest offer daily mass, so I felt it would be appropriate to accept the donation of the Corpus of Christ for integration into this church named after the founder of the Jesuits, St. Ignatius Loyola. In this way this heritage piece remains in use in our Archdiocese.

As a result, we will be moving the image of the Resurrected Christ to the back wall of the church (below the large circular window) and placing the Corpus of Christ (with a new donated cross in maple wood) behind the altar. We are pleased that this large Cross and Corpus fits beautifully into our space! At each door of the church today, you will find a photo image of how this Cross and Corpus will look in our sanctuary. To quote Pope Francis:

The cross is not simply a decoration, much less a fashion accessory, but is, instead, a religious sign to contemplate and comprehend. In the image of Jesus Crucified is revealed the mystery of the death of the Son of God as supreme act of love" -Pope Francis, March 18, 2018

We thank the Sisters of St. Joseph and look forward to welcoming their current leadership team to our parish this fall when we formally bless the new Cross and Corpus of Christ.
