As we begin another year of ministry Fr. Charles, Caroline, Carol and I look forward to an exciting fall as we renew our commitment to Liturgy of the Word for Children (new volunteers at both 10:30 a.m. and Noon Masses welcome!), announce a new direction for our Youth Ministry (introducing *Edge* for our Grade 6-8 age group) and introduce two new shared ministries with Merciful Redeemer Parish (*Forged* Ministry for Young Adults and *Men's Fraternity*...see below).

I look forward to working part-time with the Catholic students and faculty at UTM, assisted by Veronica Pereira, full-time Director of Campus Ministry at UTM. The Cardinal has also appointed Fr. Charles as a Sessional Lecturer at St. Augustine's Seminary, Scarborough while remaining our associate pastor. He will be teaching Sacramental Theology to the Permanent Diaconate Training Program candidates this weekend and one weekend each in January and February 2019.

**Update of Hope for Haiti...**

Although I was unable to travel to Haiti in July due to civil unrest, the parish was able to ship two containers and they arrived safely in the Diocese of Jacmel on Saturday, July 28. Extra funds not used for shipping costs were sent to the Diocese of Jacmel for use in improving the schools which are still not fully repaired since the 2010 earthquake. Here is an excerpt from an e-mail that I received from Fr. Louis Philippe Benoit, Diocesan Director of Education: *We have been waiting for you for some time in Haiti, especially in Jacmel. Unfortunately, the unfolding of the political situation has changed everything. We are still waiting for you. We hope this will be possible very soon. I take this opportunity to thank you for agreeing to support education in the Diocese of Jacmel. Bishop Launay made education a priority and I believe this is one of the ways to achieve the desired development for Haiti. We are all working to supervise children and young people. Once again, I wish to express my gratitude to you, on behalf of Bishop Launay and his Vicar General, Monsignor Sauveur Content. The Diocese of Jacmel always counts on your generosity and the generosity of your parishioners. I beg you, dear Father Tim, to receive the expression of my best regards.*

**Little Rock Bible Study - PSALMS II...**

The Book of the Psalms is a unique collection of the song-prayers of Israel. To study Psalms is to study prayer and ultimately enter into prayer. The study will challenge participants to reflect on their own prayer and life experiences. Psalms II focuses on a selection of twenty-eight psalms divided into three categories: Royal Psalms, Psalms of Lament and Psalms of Declarative Praise. The Royal Psalms reflect the belief in ancient Israel that the king was "anointed" by God to be "the instrument of God's concern for the people". Psalms of Lament express the sorrow of the soul in distress and of the individual's and the community's need to turn to God to be healed or rescued. Psalms of Declarative Praise are prayers of thanksgiving that praise God for rescue or healing from dire situations. We begin this 7-week study on Thursday, September 27 at 7:00 p.m. in the parish hall. Registration is \$30 per participant. All are welcome!
