We will celebrate All Souls Day on Friday, November 2 with special masses for our beloved deceased relatives and friends offered at 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. The evening mass will be followed by a Holy Hour during which we will pray for our beloved deceased.

Eternal Rest Grant unto Them O Lord...

Beginning on the weekend of November 3/4 and throughout the month of November, the Church's tradition of praying for our deceased relatives and friends will be observed at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish by the offering of all Saturday evening and Sunday Masses for them.

Again this year, you are asked to record the names of those you wish us to remember at Mass in November on the envelopes provided for that purpose (attached to this weekend's bulletin or available at the doors of the church) and to place your envelope in the basket near the altar, where the Basket of Remembrance will remain throughout the month of November. Please note that no offering is required - we are much more interested in recording the names of those you wish remembered at mass! However, any donations are received will be used to support our Refugee Resettlement Committee, who are now in the process of sponsoring a family of five from in Togo, West Africa. This single mom and her four children are currently living in asylum in Ghana- please pray for them as we are still approximately 2-3 years from welcoming them to Canada!

On Saturday, November 3 we will offer a 9:00 a.m. special mass as we gather to pray for our beloved dead especially for those who have died this past year. While letters of invitation have been sent to those families whose loved ones have been buried from St. Ignatius Loyola Church over the past year, all are welcome to attend and to contribute names of those who have recently died. Upon entering the church that morning you will be asked to record the name of your loved ones who have died in the past year on a small card, which will be brought up to the altar and the names announced during the mass. Please join us, especially if your family has lost a loved one recently!
