This single mom and her four children are currently living in asylum in Ghana. Please pray for them as we are approximately 2-3 years from welcoming them to Canada!

EDGE is a Catholic middle school ministry aimed to present the truths of the Catholic faith in a hands-on and relevant format with resources designed to meet the spiritual, physical, emotional, educational and social needs of these youth. Having the three grades together helps provide a positive transition for sixth graders, a year of development for the seventh graders and a year for the eighth graders to be role models.

We hope that in a year or two, we can begin the other part of this program called **LIFE TEEN** which is directed at High School Youth in grades 9 - 12. In the meantime, some of our high school youth parishioners will be helping as Teen Leaders in the **EDGE** Leadership Core Team.

2019 Offertory Envelopes/Pre-Authorized Giving...

Offertory envelopes for 2019 are available for pick up in the vestibule. Please continue to include your first and last name and address (or an address label) on the first 3 envelopes. Your new envelope number will be recorded so there is no need to search for your 2018 envelope box.

If you are not currently registered in the parish and wish to use Offertory envelopes, please fill out the parish registration form on the table (noting the envelope number you have taken) and return the form to the parish office.

I thank those who are currently using the option of Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) here at the parish and ask that you pick up a set of 2019 envelopes for the special collection envelopes are not part of PAG. I myself use P.A.G. and would strongly encourage this practice for others especially for those who are away from the parish on a seasonal basis. Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG) allows families and individuals to specify a monthly donation amount to the parish, and to have this amount directly withdrawn from their bank account through a pre-authorized debit.
