HOLY WEEK 2019...begins today with Palm Sunday...our full Holy Week Schedule is on the opposite page. I draw your attention to the following:

Confession/Sacrament of Reconciliation...

In preparation for the renewal of our baptismal promises at Easter, you are welcome to celebrate the sacrament on either Tuesday or Wednesday evening this week between 7:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m.

Easter Triduum...

More and more Catholics are re-discovering the richness of experiencing the Easter Triduum in its three parts – Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper 7:30 p.m., one of our three Good Friday Services 10:30 a.m. (Children's Celebration), 1:00 p.m. or 3:00 p.m., and the Easter Vigil on Saturday April 20 at 8:30 p.m. I invite you to make these three celebrations your priority in Holy Week 2019.

Holy Thursday Mass and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament...

Immediately following the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:30 p.m. there will be a formal procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Parish Hall where a special chapel will be set up so that we may pray and meditate on the last hours of Jesus life and the suffering he endured for our sake. Please join us for an hour or even just a few moments. Adoration concludes at Midnight.
