**HOLY WEEK 2019...begins today with Palm Sunday...**our full Holy Week Schedule is on the opposite page. I draw your attention to the following:

**Confession/ Sacrament of Reconciliation...**

In preparation for the renewal of our baptismal promises at Easter, you are welcome to celebrate the sacrament on either Tuesday or Wednesday evening this week between 7:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m.

**Easter Triduum...**

More and more Catholics are re-discovering the richness of experiencing the Easter Triduum in its three parts – Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper 7:30 p.m., one of our three Good Friday Services 10:30 a.m. (Children's Celebration), 1:00 p.m. or 3:00 p.m., and the Easter Vigil on Saturday April 20 at 8:30 p.m. I invite you to make these three celebrations your priority in Holy Week 2019.

**Holy Thursday Mass and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament...**

Immediately following the Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:30 p.m. there will be a formal procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Parish Hall where a special chapel will be set up so that we may pray and meditate on the last hours of Jesus life and the suffering he endured for our sake.
