#### From the Desk of Fr. Tim...

For many years we have been living with inadequate office and meeting space here at St. Ignatius Loyola parish. We have now engaged a contractor to expand the parish offices along with a reception area to provide separate offices for the pastor and associate pastor, our lay pastoral associate and our UTM campus minister. The renovations will also include a new meeting room (for groups of up to 14 people) which we will also use on Sundays for the counting of the offertory collection.

We will do all of this by taking over the small chapel area at the back of the church rather than a much more expensive expansion of our building. Attendance at each Sunday mass has been stable in recent years and we can fit our numbers into the seating in the main body of the church.

To accommodate those who enjoy sitting in the chapel area and receiving communion in their seats, we have arranged for a dedicated handicapped seating area near the doors to the parish hall. This space will easily accommodate walkers and wheelchairs. This area is close to handicapped parking and the special passenger drop off zone along the south-side wall of the church.

The renovation project will begin later this month and hopefully be completed by October. It will be done in two phases to allow the continuous operation of our offices during the construction period. A "Before" and "After" floor plan of our renovations is posted at each door of the church this weekend for your review.

#### Family of Faith Update...

We continue to be grateful for the generosity of our parishioners here at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish, whose contributions of almost \$1.5 million in donations and pledges to the campaign. They have helped to provide resources for parishes, investments in youth ministry, campus chaplaincy programs and restoration work at St. Michael's Cathedral. We will retain our share of \$645,000 of these funds here at the parish level to offset the cost of our 2015 parking expansion/Glen Erin Drive access project which has had such a positive effect on our weekend mass parking. As of the end of December 2018 through your generosity, we have now collected \$1,151,187 of which we have retained \$377, 866 in the parish. As we retain 75% of each dollar collected in this phase of the campaign, we are especially grateful for your completion of existing pledge amounts!

#### Pastoral References for Catholic Teacher Applicants...

If you or one of your children are currently studying to become a teacher in our Catholic schools, part of the Board's application process includes a letter of reference from your pastor. If you are from this parish and intend to ask for a reference letter, please note that you will have to be attending Mass here regularly before such a recommendation will be given. If the teacher candidate is currently attending Teacher's College and intends to use St. Ignatius Loyola parish to request the pastoral reference and they are away at school, they will be required to obtain a letter from the pastor of the parish where they are attending while away at school.
