# From the Desk of Fr. Tim...

## Pentecost Sunday...

By the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost, Christ's paschal mystery was brought to its completion, the Holy Trinity was fully revealed, and the Church was made manifest to the world. Saint Thomas Aquinas says that the Holy Spirit interiorly perfects our spirit, communicating to it a new dynamism so that it refrains from evil for love. With the Holy Spirit within us *"it is quite natural for people who had been absorbed by the things of this world to become entirely other-worldly in outlook, and for cowards to become people of great courage"* (Saint Cyril of Alexandria).

Let us pray that the outpouring of the Holy Spirit will renew our outlook and give us the courage to renew our lives and help us in turn to renew the face of the earth!

## Office and Sacristy Renovations: Summer 2019...

For many years we have been living with inadequate office and meeting space here at St. Ignatius Loyola. We have engaged a contractor to expand the parish offices (with a reception area), providing separate offices for the pastor, the associate pastor, the lay pastoral associate and our UTM campus minister. The renovations will also include a new meeting room (for groups of up to 14 people) which we will also use on Sunday for the counting of the offertory collection.

We will do all of this by taking over the small chapel area at the back of the church, rather than a much more expensive expansion of our building. While attendance at each Sunday mass has been stable in recent years, we can fit our numbers into the seating in the main body of the church.

To accommodate those who enjoy sitting in the chapel area to receive communion in their seats, we arranged for a dedicated handicapped seating area near the doors to the parish hall (with space for walkers and wheelchairs). This is close to handicapped parking and the special passenger drop off zone along the side wall of the church.

This project will start later this month and hopefully be completed by October. It will be done in two phases to allow the continuous operation of our offices during construction. A *Before* and *After* floor plan of our renovations is posted at each door of the church this weekend for your review.

# Family of Faith Update...

We continue to be grateful for the generosity of our parishioners here at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish whose contributions of almost \$1.5 million in donations and pledges to the campaign have helped to provide resources for parishes, investments in youth ministry and campus chaplaincy programs and restoration work at St. Michael's Cathedral. We will retain our share of \$645,000 of these funds here at the parish level to offset the cost of our 2015 parking expansion/Glen Erin Drive access project which has had such a positive effect on our weekend mass parking. As of the end of December 2018 through your generosity we have now collected \$1,151,187 of which we have retained \$377, 866 in the parish. As we retain 75% of each dollar collected in this phase of the campaign are especially grateful for your completion of existing pledge amounts!
