From the Desk of Fr. Tim...

Welcome Back...Coffee Sunday September 14/15...

As we begin another year of ministry, we will formally welcome Fr. Mauricio Sanjines to the parish at our first Coffee Sunday on September 14/15 after each mass in the parish hall. We will also be having a sign-up board for the many items that our new refugee family of five from Togo will need upon their arrival in Mississauga on October 3 (see item below).

We also resume many of our programmes during the coming weeks leading up to our Ministry Fair on October 19/20, opportunities for each one of us to strive to fully live out our parish mission statement:

St. Ignatius Loyola Parish is a welcoming and diverse Roman Catholic community of faith that,
through celebration of our many gifts and talents,
strives to build our lives in the image of Christ.

We do so through our commitment to loving service of one another
and of our broader community, all "for the greater glory of God."

Welcome Bill Assaba and Family!

Our Refugee Committee met on Tuesday evening to begin to plan for the earlier than expected arrival of our refugee family from Togo on October 3: single mom Bill Assaba and her four children: Paulina, aged 22, Gila, aged 20, Didian, aged 18 and Joshua, aged 6. Bill fled Togo over 25 years ago and has been living in the Krisan Refugee Camp in Ghana since then and is raising her family there. In her own words she says:

I feel that life in this refugee camp will never get better for me, less of even taking care of my family. I break my back day and night just to take care of my children. I burn Charcoal, push wood, I wash people's clothes and even carry blocks at the construction site.

We thank God that she and her family will soon be free of life in that camp, and are asking for assistance in three areas:

- i) Accommodation: We are searching for a 2- or 3-bedroom apartment in our area for October 1, 2019. Please contact me at the parish office as soon as possible if you know of any apartments that are coming available.
- ii) Refugee Committee Membership: We thank the 15 people who showed up at our meeting on Tuesday to assist with the various tasks that are required both in preparation for and upon arrival of our family. Norm Medeiros, Chair, would welcome more members and may be reached via e-mail at medeirn@sympatico.ca. While any assistance would be helpful, we are particularly interested in those who would be available during the day to assist with orientation and driving to appointments.
- iii) Furniture, housewares, clothing: Thank you for **not** dropping items off at the parish office or hall before our sign-up weekend (September 14/15 after each mass). At that time, you will be asked to sign-up to provide specific items for our refugee family of five. In that way, we avoid duplication of some items and shortage of other needed items.

Welcome Lisa Cabellero, UTM Campus Minister...

Next weekend after each mass, I will invite Lisa Caballero to say a few words about our ministry in Catholic Chaplaincy at the University of Toronto Mississauga Campus. Lisa is a UTM graduate and a former member of the UTM Catholic Club Executive when she was an undergraduate student. She has worked in the Office of Catholic Youth before and during her graduate studies at Regis College University of Toronto where she recently completed her Master of Divinity degree. Most recently she was on staff as a lay pastoral associate at St. Barnabus Parish in Scarborough.

All are welcome to join us on campus for mass at the Student Centre on Tuesdays at 12:10 p.m. beginning on September 17. A special welcome is extended for the mass on Tuesday, October 1 when Bishop Boissonneau will celebrate the mass and formally commission Lisa as the full-time campus minister.
