We will also be having a sign-up board for the many items that our new refugee family of five from Togo will need upon their arrival in Mississauga on October 3.

We also resume many of our programmes during the coming weeks leading up to our *Ministry Fair* on October 19/20, opportunities for each one of us to strive to fully live out our parish mission statement:

St. Ignatius Loyola Parish is a welcoming and diverse Roman Catholic community of faith that, through celebration of our many gifts and talents, strives to build our lives in the image of Christ. We do so through our commitment to loving service of one another and of our broader community, all "for the greater glory of God."

Welcome Bill Assaba and Family!

Our Refugee Committee has begun to plan for the earlier than expected arrival of our refugee family from Togo on October 3: single mom Bill Assaba and her four children: Paulina, aged 22, Gila, aged 20, Didian, aged 18 and Joshua, aged 6. Bill fled Togo over 25 years ago and has been living in Krisan Refugee Camp since then and raising her family there. In her own words she says: *I feel that life in this refugee camp will never get better for me, less of even taking care of my family. I break my back day and night just to take care of my children. I burn Charcoal, push wood, I wash people clothes and even carry blocks at the construction site.*

We thank God that she and her family will soon be free of life in that camp, and ask for assistance with:

- (1) Accommodation: We are searching for a 2- or 3-bedroom apartment in our area for October 1, 2019 Please contact me at the parish office as soon as possible if you know of any apartments that are coming available.
- (2) Refugee Committee Membership: We thank the 17 people who showed up at our meeting on Tuesday to assist with the various tasks that are required both in preparation for and upon arrival of our family. Norm Medeiros, chair, would welcome more members and may be reached via e-mail at medeirn@rogers.com. While any assistance would be helpful, we are particularly interested in those who would be available during the day to assist with orientation and driving to appointments.
- (3) Furniture, housewares, clothing needed. Please do not bring items to the parish office or hall before our sign-up weekend (September 14/15). At that time, you can to sign-up to provide specific items.
- (4) Financial Support through our *Refugee Collection* next weekend Through your generous support of the All Souls envelopes for the last 2 years and through other donations, we have already raised 50% or \$17,900 of the estimated \$34,900 required to support this family for one year.
