As we begin another year of ministry you are invited to join us as in the parish hall after all the masses as we formally welcome Fr. Mauricio Sanjines to the parish. We are also launching this year's EDGE Youth Ministry for those in Grades 6-8 as well as having a sign- up board for the many items that our new refugee family of five from Togo will need upon their arrival in Mississauga on October 3 (see item below).

We also resume many of our programmes leading up to our *Ministry Fair* on the weekend of October 19/20, opportunities for each one of us to strive to fully live out our parish mission statement:

St. Ignatius Loyola Parish is a welcoming and diverse Roman Catholic community of faith that, through celebration of our many gifts and talents, strives to build our lives in the image of Christ. We do so through our commitment to loving service of one another and of our broader community, all "for the greater glory of God."

EDGE Ministry...

Our parish will continue with the EDGE Program geared to students in Grade 6, 7, 8. EDGE is a Catholic middle school ministry that aims to present the truths of the Catholic faith in a hands-on and relevant format designed to meet the spiritual, physical, emotional, educational and social needs of this age group. Having the three grades together helps provide a positive transition for sixth graders, a year of development for seventh graders and a year to be role models for eight graders. The leadership core team includes some of our high school youth parishioners. EDGE Youth Ministry Nights will take place every 1st and 3rd Mondays of the month from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. beginning this Monday, September 16 in the parish hall. Bring a friend!

Hurricane Dorian Disaster Relief...

Hurricane Dorian devastated the Caribbean nation of the Bahamas where more than 70,000 people are expected to need emergency assistance, including food, shelter, electricity and safe drinking water.
