We thank all of you for your patience during this extended construction period, with special thanks to Chico Bolivar, our caretaker, and all the parish staff for their extra efforts during these past six months. We are very happy with the work done by the general contractor GQ Home Improvements (owned by our parishioner, Greg Quiaoit) and would recommend him to your family for your own home improvements.

As announced last weekend, we are happy to name our boardroom (the pastor's former office space) as the Monsignor Joseph Shiels Room in honour of our former pastor who served here for 21 years (1992-2013) and who still lives in our parish. This space can seat up to 12 people around the conference table. We also have an adjacent small meeting room that can accommodate up to eight people.

Advent 2019...

Advent is a season of joyful preparation for the coming of Christ, but the joy lies in knowing that God will clear away all the obstacles we ourselves have made to his coming into our lives in full. We begin therefore in a spirit of repentance as we "await with joyful hope the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ". In that spirit, I offer the following suggestions for celebrating Advent:

PRAY daily using the Sunday or Weekday Advent Mass Readings

ATTEND WEEKDAY MASS during this season. The powerful symbolism of the readings and prayers will be a peaceful reprieve from this busy season.

INVITE a friend, loved one or neighbour to join you for Sunday mass.

SUPPORT THOSE IN NEED through the St. Vincent de Paul Society's Collection (your donation is used to fund Outreach throughout 2020), or through your donations of gift cards to the St. Vincent de Paul (for Christmas Outreach). Special St. Vincent de Paul envelopes are at the doors of the church and donations will be accepted throughout December. Your financial and gift card donations may be dropped off to the parish office in the weeks to come.

VISIT the lonely, the sick or those who mourn perhaps inviting one of them to join your family for Christmas mass or dinner this year.

BE RECONCILED to God and one another through the healing Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) before Christmas. Advent has been called a "smaller Lent," and is as important a season as the one leading up to the Resurrection. We don't often associate penance with Advent, and yet there's a strong current of thought that says it should be part of our preparation for whatever lies ahead. This Sacrament is available as follows:

t every Saturday between 4:00 - 4:30 p.m., or anytime by appointment

† during the Archdiocesan Week of Confessions (see <u>www.archtoronto.org/confession/</u> for times of confessions for Mississauga parishes). In our parish, reconciliation will take place on Thursday, December 19 from 9:30 - 11:30 a.m., 4:00 - 6:00 p.m., and from 7:00 - 8:30 p.m.

2020 Offertory Envelopes/Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG)...

Thank you for your continued weekly support of our parish through use of Sunday Offertory Envelopes (our 2020 envelopes are now ready for pick up in both foyers of the church), or through our Pre-Authorized Giving Programme, which allows families and individuals to specify a monthly donation amount to the parish, and to have this amount directly withdrawn from their bank account through a pre-authorized debit. Registration forms for new parishioners (including PAG application) are in the foyer of the church.

Family of Faith Update...

We continue to be grateful for the generosity of our parishioners here at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish, whose contributions of almost \$1.5 million in donations and pledges to the campaign have helped to provide resources for parishes, investments in youth ministry and campus chaplaincy programs and restoration work at St. Michael's Cathedral. We will retain our share of \$575,000 of these funds here at the parish level to offset the cost of our 2015 parking expansion/Glen Erin Drive access project- which has had such a positive effect on our weekend mass parking problem. As of June 30, 2019, through your generosity we have now received \$1,221,000 in pledges of which the parish has retained \$430,000. We would be especially grateful that you complete your existing pledge amounts as 75% of each dollar collected remains here in the parish.

Pledge amounts given through cheque, credit card or donation of securities prior to December 31, 2019 will receive a 2019 tax receipt directly from the Family of Faith campaign office. If you wish to make any additional payments on your pledges prior to year-end, they too will receive a tax receipt for 2019.
