# From the Desk of Fr. Tim...

# Annual Financial Report to the Parish...

As we present our 2019 Annual Financial Report this weekend, I wish to thank each of you for your continued support of our parish. Total collections were up nearly 5% from 2018 levels. This is largely attributable to the increase in donations to *ShareLife*, Mission Co-op, and Humanitarian Relief for the victims of Hurricane Dorian (matched by the Canadian Government), as well as your generous support of the Bill Family from Togo through the Refugee Sponsorship Program.

Special thanks to those who continue to fulfil your pledges to the *Family of Faith*. Tax receipts for your *Family of Faith* donations will be mailed to you directly from the Archdiocese of Toronto.

Our parish expenditures, excluding Special Collections, Refugee Sponsorship expenses, and a large 2019 HST refund, were down slightly when compared to 2018. This past year, we did complete one capital project: the parish office and sacristy renovation as well as the front foyer washroom.

Our parish currently has a capital fund balance of \$1.18 million on deposit with the Archdiocese. While these funds remain the property of our parish, the Archdiocese loans them out to other parishes to assist them in the building and renovation of churches, while paying interest on the fund balance. While a capital fund of \$1.18 million is a significant amount of money, other improvements being considered will improve the building and parish life for all of us!

Tax receipts for the year 2019 are available in the main foyer of the church today. As your pastor I thank you sincerely for your continued and generous support - both financial and in your dedicated service to our parish community. It is a privilege to be the pastor of this busy and vibrant parish! I also wish to thank the members of our Property and Finance Committee who are presenting the financial report at each mass this weekend, and the entire committee for their wise advice and assistance: *Christine Burton, Michael Furlong, Peter Kastelic, Maureen Kelly, Tom Pippy and Fred Taggart.*

## THANK YOU FOR YOUR GENEROSITY

Our parish currently has a capital fund balance of \$1,180,000 (2018 \$1,321,403) on deposit with the Archdiocese. This year we spent \$395,000 for the expansion of our parish offices, sacristy and new meeting rooms. We added \$139,240 to this fund through Family of Faith campaign pledges, \$80,000 from our operating account, and a further \$34,084 as interest payments. While these funds remain the property of our parish, the Archdiocese loans them out to other parishes to assist them in the building and renovation of churches, while paying interest on the fund balance.

We recognize that \$1.2 million is a significant amount of money on deposit, but are also aware that our 30 year old buildings will continue to need capital retrofit and upgrading in the future.
