Ordinandi Spiritual Bouquet "Here I am Lord, I come to do your will." Psalm 40

Each year the Catholic Women's League collects a Spiritual Bouquet that is presented to the Ordinandi candidates at the Ordinandi Dinner. This year's dinner is on March 3.

A Spiritual Bouquet is a collection of devotional acts such as Masses, Communions, Rosaries, Eucharistic Adorations, visits to the Blessed Sacrament, Stations of the Cross, Sacrifices and Prayers. These offering are not paid offerings - they are devotions done freely and lovingly to show support and encouragement as the candidates prepare themselves to work as Priests in our Catholic Church. There is no time limit, you can offer as many devotions as you wish, and you may start_anytime. Everyone is invited to participate. If you decide to offer devotions over the next year you could calculate your pledges as follows: If you - attend Sunday Masses you could pledge 52 Masses; go to communion each Sunday — you could pledge 52 Communions; attend weekday Masses and Communion you could tally and pledge those #s. If you say the Rosary, visit the Blessed Sacrament, do the Stations of the Cross, say prayers or make sacrifices — you could pledge those.

The Ordinandi candidates have always expressed that receiving a Spiritual Bouquet is one of the best gifts they receive. They are strengthened in knowing how much they are prayed for as they embark on a journey of service in the Lord. Last year's Ordinandi Spiritual Bouquet totaled over 2 million devotions.
