Ordinandi Spiritual Bouquet "Here I am Lord, I come to do your will." Psalm 40...

Each year the Catholic Women's League collects a Spiritual Bouquet that is presented to the Ordinandi candidates at the Ordinandi Dinner. This year's dinner is on March 3.

A Spiritual Bouquet is a collection of devotional acts such as Masses, Communions, Rosaries, Eucharistic Adorations, visits to the Blessed Sacrament, Stations of the Cross, Sacrifices and Prayers. These offering <u>are not paid offerings</u> - they are devotions done freely and lovingly to show support and encouragement as the candidates prepare themselves to work as Priests in our Catholic Church. There is <u>no time limit</u>, you can offer as many devotions as you wish, and you may start_anytime. Everyone is invited to participate. If you decide to offer devotions over the next year you could calculate your pledges as follows: If you - attend Sunday Masses you could pledge 52 Masses; go to communion each Sunday – you could pledge 52 Communions; attend weekday Masses and Communion you could tally and pledge those #s. If you say the Rosary, visit the Blessed Sacrament, do the Stations of the Cross, say prayers or make sacrifices – you could pledge those.

The Ordinandi candidates have always expressed that receiving a Spiritual Bouquet is one of the best gifts they receive. They are strengthened in knowing how much they are prayed for as they embark on a journey of service in the Lord. Last year's Ordinandi Spiritual Bouquet totaled over 2 million devotions.
