The livestreaming of the mass on our parish website will also continue each Sunday at 9:00 a.m. for those who cannot physically join us for mass at the church.

#### **3. ShareLife**

We thank you for your great response thus far to this year's *ShareLife* campaign- we have received \$165,000 in donations to date towards our parish goal of \$234,600. This includes the following donations from our school communities: Loyola Catholic Secondary \$3,300, All Saints \$859, St. Clare \$1,526 and St. Mark \$931.

Due to COVID-19 the campaign will now extend into the fall with special collection dates of September 13 and October 11 for those who have not yet had a chance to donate this year.
