The Eucharist in Scripture is this fall's bible study topic. It will explore the biblical theme of meals shared in faithful fellowship and in covenant relationship with God. I am pleased to report that they are doing well and are now able to be financially independent and able to remain in the rented accommodation that we provided for them throughout this past year.

This year's Archdiocesan Mass for the World Day of Migrants & Refugees will be celebrated virtually by Cardinal Collins today at the 10:00 AM Mass at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica. The Mass will be livestreamed here: (check link for St. Michael's) Following the livestream, the Mass along with prerecorded videos from several guest speakers will be made available on ORAT's website: (check address for website).

These are intended to draw our attention to the plight of so many who have been displaced from their homes and homelands. Please pray for the precarious status of refugees during this time of pandemic.

Confirmation Celebrations - October 2020

For those families who were registered with us to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in May 2020, I am happy to inform you that we are now able to proceed with the Sacrament of Confirmation for your child. There will be only 22 candidates per celebration, with each candidate limited to inviting his or her sponsor and a maximum of 4 family members from the same social bubble. Your family will be seated together in one row/pew (with the sponsor socially distanced). Attendance is mandatory (candidate and one parent) for a Confirmation rehearsal. The sponsor should also attend this rehearsal if possible.

ShareLife Update
