From the Desk of Fr. Tim

Dear Parishioners,

We have all been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, whether through isolation, illness, or financial challenges. Please do not hesitate to contact one of the parish staff or me if we can assist you during these challenging times. I am writing to update you on how we are doing as a parish faith community.

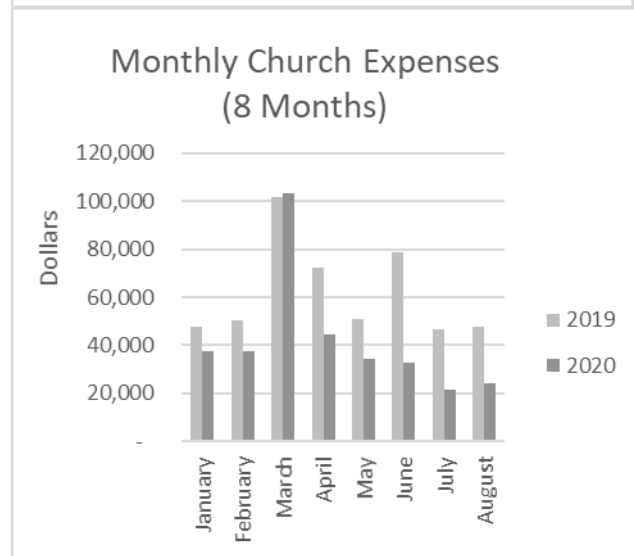
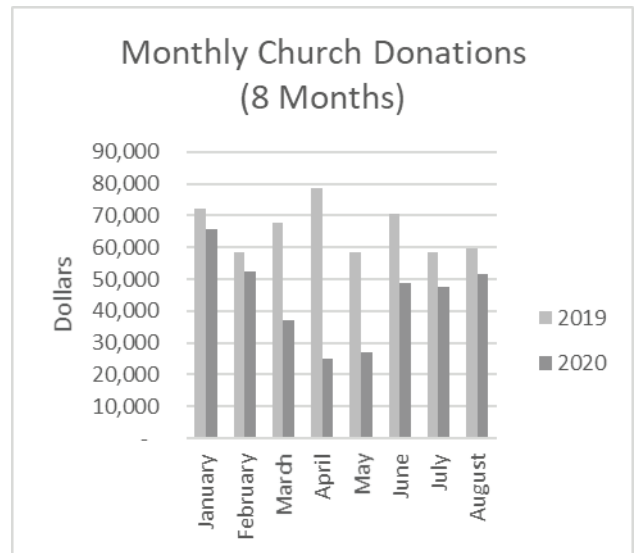
During our parish closure (mid-March to late June), we reached out to you via livestream of the Sunday mass, YouTube video updates and personal telephone calls to almost 1,500 families.

Since our re-opening in June, we are proud to have ensured a safe environment for worship here at St. Ignatius Loyola through the hard work of many volunteer cleaners, ushers, and livestream operators, in addition to the continued involvement of readers, ministers of the eucharist and musicians.

Social distancing has impacted attendance at Sunday Masses. Attendance is smaller than before (currently about 25 per cent of normal - with socially distanced seating in the church and parish hall). We know that this may continue for some time and are happy to be live streaming the Sunday 9 a.m. mass via our website to those who cannot attend in person due to health or other issues at this time.

The pandemic has also had a negative impact on our financial health in 2020 as the charts on the following page indicate. I want to draw your attention to the following items:

- *Offertory revenue in the March-August period declined by 40 % as compared to 2019. We thank all those who have continued their contributions to the parish even though many of you cannot attend in person.
- * In that same period, we noted a decline in operating expenses of 34% as we eliminated any non-essential costs and planned renovation projects. We have also benefitted from the 75 per cent government wage subsidy (CEWS) for all clergy and lay employees.
- *From September onwards, the CEWS subsidy is greatly reduced, leaving us with a projected operating deficit of up to \$50,000 for the last four months of 2020. As we move into the fall season, we remain in a time of great uncertainty about the pandemic's direction and the possibility of another church closure. As a result, we ask your assistance with the following:



*Remember that whether the church itself remains open or closed, we are always ready to assist you or a family member via telephone message or email. When working remotely, we monitor our messages daily.

*Consider switching your support of the parish to Pre-Authorized Giving (PAG forms available through parish website) or by credit card, or single or monthly donations through the "Donate now" button at www.archtoronto.org.

*If you are attending mass at the church, you will soon be able to use our new touchless debit/credit card machine for processing one-time donations to the parish. Once the machine arrives you will be able to visit the parish office before or after one of the weekend masses or during weekday office hours.

*Please help us update your contact information, especially your email address by sending an email to the parish office StIgnatiusLoyolaMI@archtoronto.org using your current email address and place in the subject line "Email address update." Be sure to include

your name, address, and telephone number in the email body.

Once again, I would like to thank each of you for your extraordinary support during these challenging times. I cannot express how much we appreciate your loyalty, ongoing support, and generosity. Should you have any questions, please be in touch with us.

Confirmation Celebrations - October 2020

We can proceed with the Sacrament of Confirmation for those families who were already registered with us for May 2020. There will be only 22 candidates per celebration, with each candidate limited to inviting his or her sponsor and a maximum of 4 family members from the same social bubble. Your family will be seated together in one row/pew (with the sponsor socially distanced). Attendance is mandatory (candidate and one parent) for a Confirmation rehearsal. The sponsor should also attend this rehearsal if possible.


