From the Desk of Fr. Tim

Peel Public Health Restrictions – Message from Cardinal Collins

Thank you for your continued efforts to allow us to safely celebrate the sacraments and pray together since our reopening in June. In recent days, the Province of Ontario has announced a new colour coded system ("Keeping Ontario Safe and Open") that will identify various levels of restrictions regionally to address the spread of Covid-19. Recognizing the current number of cases in Peel, the region is moving into "Control" stage (Red) that brings with it, certain restrictions.

The Medical Officer of Health provided additional instruction for places of worship to follow. While initially limiting mass attendance to a maximum of 50 people per facility in the Saturday, November 7 announcement, the Region of Peel has now revised their guidance for places of worship from "instruction" to "strong recommendations". Accordingly, we have amended our implementation measures as follows:

Parishes that are responsibly implementing the *WorshipSafe* measures can continue to operate liturgical celebrations (Mass, Weddings, Funerals, Baptisms, etc.) at 30% capacity. Please ensure strict adherence to sanitization, distancing and other measures as outlined in our protocols. For us at St. Ignatius Loyola this means that we can continue to use the church and hall as we have been since June.

Recognizing the significance of the situation in Peel Region, no meetings should take place in parish halls or other church spaces at this time. This will take effect immediately until further notice.

Parish offices should move to Phase 2 – Limited Operations as previously directed. We will now open the office only Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., Saturday after the 5 p.m. mass and Sunday from 8:15 a.m. to 1:15 p.m. (Office Closed Mondays and Fridays)

To be clear, the situation in the Region of Peel is serious and requires the commitment of every parish to continue to implement our rigorous *WorshipSafe* procedures. Thank you for your patience as we work together to navigate these challenging days. Let us continue to pray for one another.

Bible Study: The Book of Genesis: Registration-Thursday November 19 at 6:30 -7:30 p.m.

A study of the book of Genesis is an invitation to contemplate the creation story and to remember with the Israelites, their ancestors in faith. Part One of this study covers Genesis 1:1—25:18 (the "pre-history" of Israel including the creation accounts, the stories of the fall and the great flood, as well as the story of Abraham and Sarah). Part Two of this study moves us forward from the time of Abraham to the unfolding of his family in the stories of Isaac and Jacob, as well as the story of Joseph and his brothers and their clans. Commentary, study and reflection questions, prayer and access to recorded lectures are included in this 10-lesson series.

Bible study registration will take place on Thursday, November 19 at 7:00 p.m. in the parish hall foyer to welcome new participants and distribute study guides and materials only. The registration and materials fee is \$40 per person for the two books. The study will begin virtually via Zoom for 10 sessions each Thursday at 7:00 p.m. on November 26 and December 3 and in the new year from January 7 until February 25, 2021. An excellent bible study to keep you busy during long winter pandemic nights.
