

### **Bible Study ACTS - The Compelling Story of the First Christians begins January 13, 2022**

ACTS is the story of how a few Christians, empowered by the Holy Spirit, were chosen to bring Christ and the Good News to the ends of the earth. They faced secular forces, internal strife, and hostile crowds, and despite all of this, they brought the kingdom of God to a broken world and the love of God to the hearts of men.

*Acts: The Spread of the Kingdom* traces how the gospel witness spread outward in waves from Jerusalem. It reveals how the seeds of Church structure and authority took root as well as how the joys and struggles of the early Christians in living the life of Christ apply to us today. This bible study will help you to see your place in the Church as a disciple of Christ.

The **20-session** extended bible study will take place via ZOOM on Thursday, January 20, 2022, from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. In-person registration will take place in the front foyer from 6:30 – 7:30 p.m. on Thursday, January 13, 2022. The cost for this extended study is \$50.
