Younas Gill and Family Arriving Soon!

Our refugee family of 6 adults from Pakistan (via Thailand) will begin to arrive on Wednesday January 26, 2022. We have secured a semi-detached townhouse for them to live in for the coming year. Currently, we are asking our parishioners for assistance in one of three ways:

i) specific donations to prepare the house for the family's arrival Please consult carefully the [Donation list of specific items](#) which are still needed. This list is on the parish website. Given health and safety concerns all soft items (mattresses, bedding, clothing) must be new. All other items can be gently used. *Should you be able to donate a specific item please send an email to: loyolarefugeecomm@gmail.com and wait for a confirmation reply before purchasing the desired item.* Donations may be dropped off in the parish hall on the weekend of February 5/6 after all masses.

ii) Donation of gift cards

iii) Monetary donations (through your own envelope marked "Refugee Family support" or using the yellow Humanitarian Relief Envelopes at each door of the church). Both gift cards and monetary donations may be left in the offertory basket in the centre aisle of the church or mailed or dropped off at the parish office (when open).

iv) Finally, we are searching for a local family doctor for this family of six...please let us know if you can assist with this request.

Thank you for your generosity in assisting our Refugee Committee in settling this family who have lived displaced in Thailand for over five years.

For parishioners already using PAG, please note that special collection envelopes are not part of PAG. You will find the special collection envelopes in your offertory envelope box.

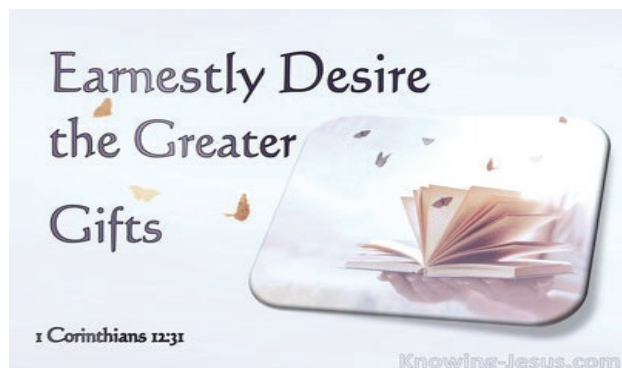
