Advent Evening of Reflection: Thursday December 8

Fr. Thomas Rosica c.s.b., will lead this year's Evening of Reflection on Thursday December 8 in the parish hall with the theme: *The Pregnant Season: A biblical spirituality for Advent & Christmas Through the lenses of the Holy Family*. Fr. Tom writes: *Advent is a pregnant season... announcing new life from God to each of us. Our Evening Reflection will reflect on the journey of the Holy Family and how it enters our own lives. Do we trust that a loving, personal God guides each of us as well as the tragic events of contemporary history? Are we so caught up in our own families or our own work that we rarely raise our eyes to the larger world of the poor on other continents?
