No doubt the question seems weird; so often we associate Lent with darker things, ashes, penance, abstinence. Pope Francis recently asked us to take a new frame of reference, not looking backward by moving – and looking – forward, **with a focus on the Transfiguration which points to Easter**. While on Sunday we will ponder the great event of the raising of Lazarus, on Monday we'll look at the Lenten journey, up the hill to the Lord and on Tuesday what the view from the mountaintop might be. The two evenings will be set in a liturgy of the Word, a prayerful setting with time for reflection.

New Archbishop of Toronto

Pope Francis has appointed Bishop Francis (Frank) Leo, currently Auxiliary Bishop of the Archdiocese of Montreal, as the 14th Archbishop of Toronto. The archbishop-designate succeeds Cardinal Thomas Collins, who has served the archdiocese since 2007.

The new archbishop will be installed at a ceremony at St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica on Saturday March 25. Everyone is invited to watch this special mass via livestream from the Cathedral Basilica. During this time of transition in the archdiocese, we give thanks for Cardinal Collins and his service to the Church and welcome Archbishop-designate Leo to the Archdiocese of Toronto!
