### Bible Study 2024

After Masses this weekend, January 6 /7, we will be having our registration for our next 10-session Bible study from Ascension Press entitled “*Jesus: The Way, the Truth and the Life.*” in the parish hall. The marvelous treasures of the Catholic Faith—the Eucharist, Mary, the saints, and the Creed—are all centered on a single figure: Jesus Christ. Jesus is more than a historical or theological figure.
