Dear Parents/Guardians,

I am writing to you today about the **Sacraments of Reconciliation (First Confession) and Eucharist (First Holy Communion)** which will both be offered to your son/daughter in Grade 2. Please know that we at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish are delighted to celebrate this spiritual milestone in the life of your child and to offer whatever assistance we can to you as parents and families to make this sacramental preparation a positive and spiritually uplifting process.

We invite and encourage you and your family to attend Sunday Masses, especially this year as your child is preparing for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist. Please visit our webpage <https://stignatiusloyolami.archtoronto.org> for our complete Mass schedule and updates.

An integral part of the student's preparation is a home program (with parental assistance) through the completion of two catechetical books entitled, "We Prepare for Reconciliation" (for First Reconciliation), and "We Share in the Eucharist" (for First Eucharist). The Registration fee of \$60 per child covers the cost of these resource books, as well as a copy of the Sunday Missal for Young Catholics, which they will receive at their First Confession. They are strongly encouraged to bring their Sunday Missals with them to Mass so that they can follow along. While the parish and school (through our Grade 2 teachers and the religious education curriculum taught by our Catholic schools) will support you in the instruction of the sacraments, your participation at home in working through these catechetical books with your child is a critical element of their preparation.

For the first time, we are opening our RCIC classes to students attending our feeder schools at no additional cost. Families who would like their child to receive additional faith formation and sacramental preparation beyond what is provided at school and at home are warmly invited to participate. To enroll your child for the RCIC classes, please indicate your interest on the registration form. **Kindly note that registration for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion Preparation with St. Ignatius Loyola Parish closes on Monday September 21, 2026.**

Between your family, our schools and our parish church, our task is to work together to help and encourage these young people appreciate and celebrate God's loving mercy through reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and communion in Christ Jesus through the Sacrament of the Eucharist. I am personally delighted to be part of this process, and I know I speak for our pastoral team as well.

I look forward to seeing you each weekend at either the Saturday evening or Sunday Mass, and especially here at the church on either **Tuesday September 29 or Wednesday September 30.**

May the Lord bless you and your families abundantly throughout this joy-filled time in your child's life.

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Dear Parents/Guardians,

We are happy to have the opportunity to work with your son/daughter this year in preparing for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion. In addition to being parishioners here at St. Ignatius Loyola Church, we are retired Catholic school teaching professionals and have been involved with the preparation of the sacraments for many years. We are very pleased to be able to assist Father Ed and Father Tobias with this program.

The primary material used for these courses are the two catechetical books entitled “We Prepare for Reconciliation” and “We share in the Eucharist” which you will receive at the registration meeting. At our first meeting, you will be assigned sections of these books to be completed before each class. You may begin the books even before the classes start to avoid rushing through it as the course progresses. Please ensure that your child brings this booklet to each class. Your child will also be required to learn the following prayers: Our Father, Hail Mary, Nicene Creed, the Act of Contrition, and all Mass prayers and responses. Copies of these prayers will be given to your child so that you can practice at home.

We will have 5 Reconciliation classes and 6 First Communion classes which will take place on Tuesdays at the Parish Hall from 4:00 – 5:15 p.m. The schedule for these classes is attached to the end of this package. Please ensure that you accompany your child when being dropped off or picked up from the church, using the back entrance. We ask that you arrive 5 minutes before the end of the class to pick up your child.

We expect that your child will attend all the classes. If an illness or an emergency does occur and your child cannot attend a specific class, please notify the parish office as soon as possible by emailing our Parish’s Lay Pastoral Associate at msiuchong@archtoronto.org, or by calling (905) 820-1444.

During this time of sacramental preparation, it is particularly important that you ensure that your child attends Mass on a weekly basis. This will be a great opportunity for your child to review the parts of the church (i.e. altar, tabernacle, stained glass windows, confessional, etc.) and the parts of the Mass which will be introduced to him/her during the classes.

We look forward to working with your child this year. Please feel free to ask any questions at any time.

Registration Requirements

To register for the 2026/2027 First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion Preparation Program at St. Ignatius Loyola Parish, families must:

- Be registered, practicing members of St. Ignatius Loyola Parish
- Attend Sunday Mass regularly
- Complete the Sacramental Preparation Form via Google Forms, *including uploading your child's baptismal certificate*
- Respond to the Lay Pastoral Associate's email prior to Friday September 25th to confirm the information submitted for your child
- Attend the **mandatory** Registration and Parent & Child Meeting on Tuesday September 29th OR Wednesday September 30th, 2026

During the mandatory parent information session on September 29th / September 30th, 2026, families will:

- Check in (Location: Parish Foyer)
- Select a preferred First Holy Communion date (first come, first serve)
- Receive program preparation resources
- Submit the \$60 registration fee (cash or cheque payable to Ignatius Loyola Parish)

Please note: The completed online registration form (Google Form and baptismal certificate submission) must be received by Monday, September 21, 2026 for your child to be registered in the 2026/2027 First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion Preparation Program.

Not yet baptized? Families with a child in Grade 2 (or older) who has not yet been baptized, but who are committed to raising their child in the Catholic faith and preparing for the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, are asked to contact our Lay Pastoral Associate, Melissa, prior to completing the online registration form.
